 All the time - all the way

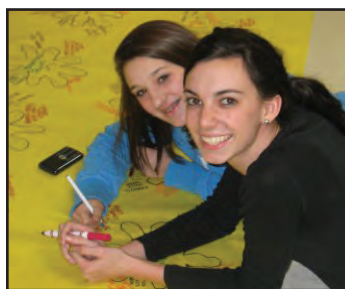
Oh - you can't tell me it's not worth tryin' for
